DEGREES OF FREEDOM

THE EXHIBITION TITLED DEGREES OF FREEDOM FROM DECEMBER 21 AT YUNT

The exhibition *Degrees of Freedom*, curated by Kerem Ozan Bayraktar with works by Sümeyra Bakır, Tayfun Erdoğmuş, Bedirhan Kılıç, Merve Karakoç, Kerem Özkan, Dila Pirinç, Beste Saraç, Ulya Soley and Berkay Tuncay will be on display at YUNT from 21 December 2024 to 11 April 2025.

The exhibition focuses on the way we perceive, construct and represent space through artistic expression. It is based on the concept of "degrees of freedom"," which explains how a system can move, transform and reshape itself depending on the environmental conditions. Instead of fixed spatial models, an approach is proposed that encompasses different intensities and possibilities of movement.

The exhibition turns away from static representations based on a linear understanding of space, which assumes that the world consists of fixed objects and entities, and focuses on the dynamic yet limited nature of reality. The exhibition highlights the different intensities, stillnesses and movements that characterize life— - especially spatial experiences - and uses techniques that explore networks of possibilities in space and their occasionally solidified boundaries.

The works on display include technical images not intended for the human eye, three-dimensional models, videos and various types of projection, as well as works that mark, transform, deconstruct and analyze accumulations in space. These works not only question conventional linear representations, but also combine the existence of art with the exploration of fields of possibility.

With this exhibition, YUNT not only embraces these alternative forms of expression, but also creates a platform for discussions about its own spatial identity. As a space open to change, YUNT designs the exhibition as both a means of expression and a field for investigation.



About YUNT:

Located in Sultanbeyli, YUNT is a non-profit art and interaction space. It aims to increase the society's opportunities to encounter artistic activities. In addition to its exhibitions and events, it enables those it comes into contact with to establish new sensory relationships with the world through its educational program and supported publications.
